

Kiwi Resin Models

1/72 Fox Moth

This kit is moulded in Urethane resin, and should be assembled with a high quality epoxy or superglue.

Before assembly it is recommended that the resin parts be washed in warm soapy water . Inspect the parts, and any flash or resin bubbles found should be removed, and any sinkholes filled.

The resin pieces can be easily removed from their moulding blocks using a sharp blade or fine toothed razor saw. Mating faces may be trued up by sanding on a flat surface with 600 grit wet and dry sandpaper.
