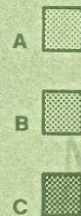


PEGASUS

 C Extra Dark Sea Grey

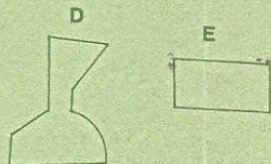


Colouring Notes: Two alternative markings are supplied with the kit, for a Mk I and a Mk II Fulmar. The major camouflage pattern is identical for both options. The Standard 1942 scheme depicted on the 3 View, consisted of a disruptive top surface camouflage of Extra Dark Sea Grey and Dark Slate Grey; with the undersurfaces in Sky Grey.

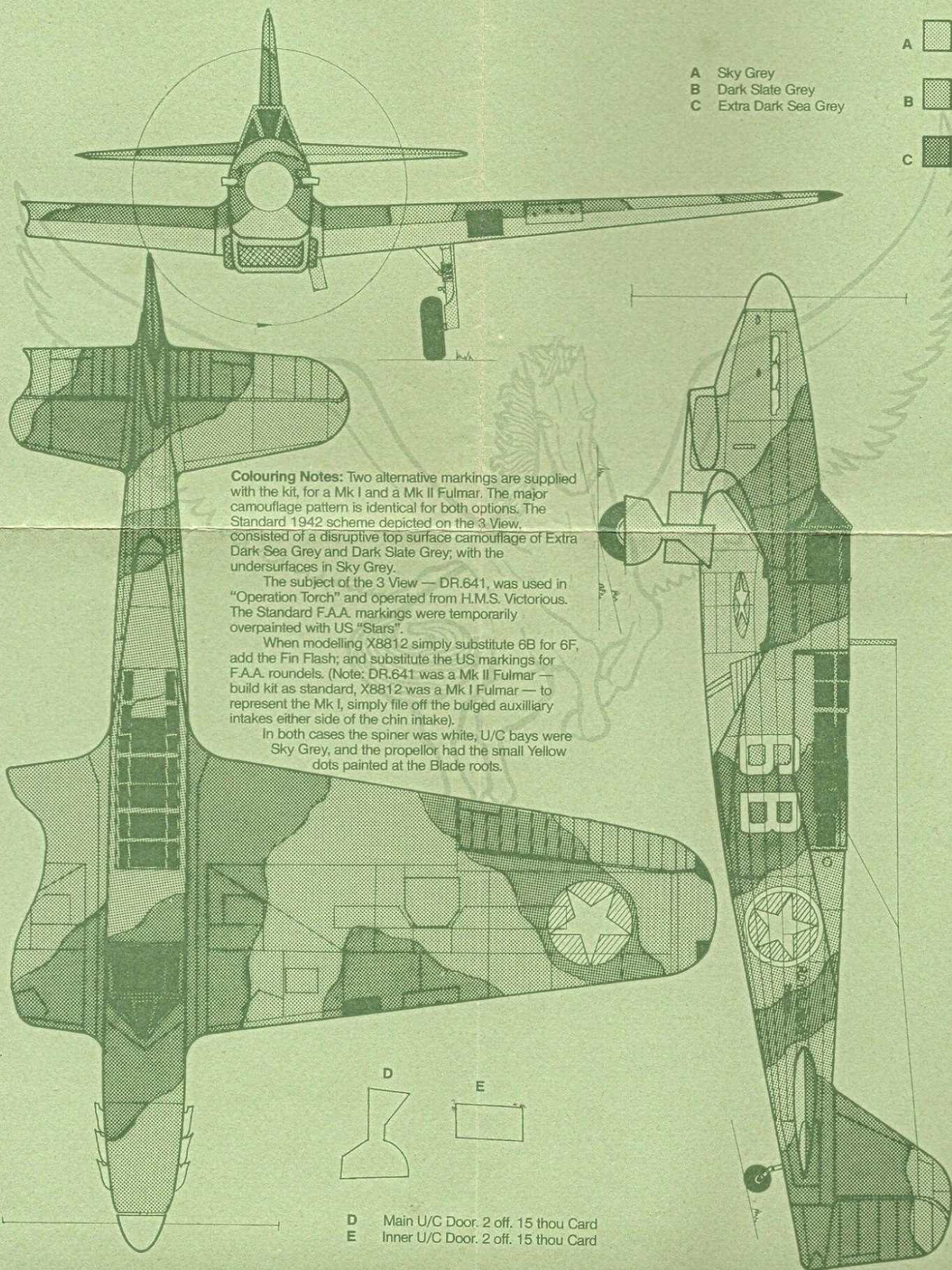
The subject of the 3 View — DR.641, was used in "Operation Torch" and operated from H.M.S. Victorious. The Standard F.A.A. markings were temporarily overpainted with US "Stars".

When modelling X8812 simply substitute 6B for 6F, add the Fin Flash; and substitute the US markings for F.A.A. roundels. (Note: DR.641 was a Mk II Fulmar — build kit as standard, X8812 was a Mk I Fulmar — to represent the Mk I, simply file off the bulged auxiliary intakes either side of the chin intake).

In both cases the spinner was white, U/C bays were Sky Grey, and the propellor had the small Yellow dots painted at the Blade roots.

 E Inner U/C Door. 2 off. 15 thou Card



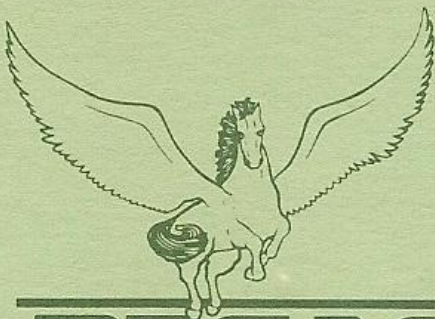
