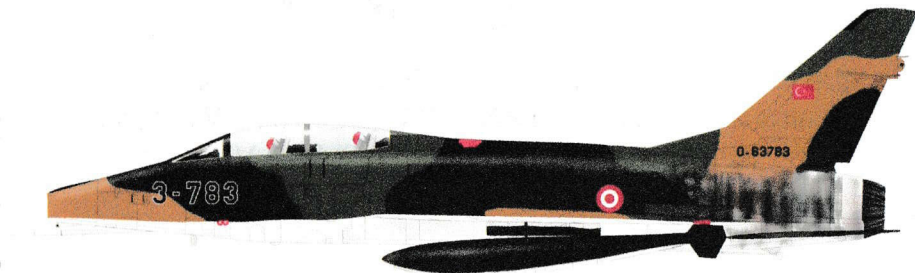
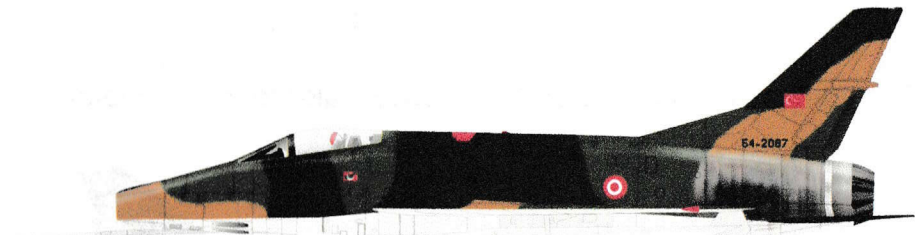

## Turkish Huns F-100 C/D/F in TUAf Services (72023)

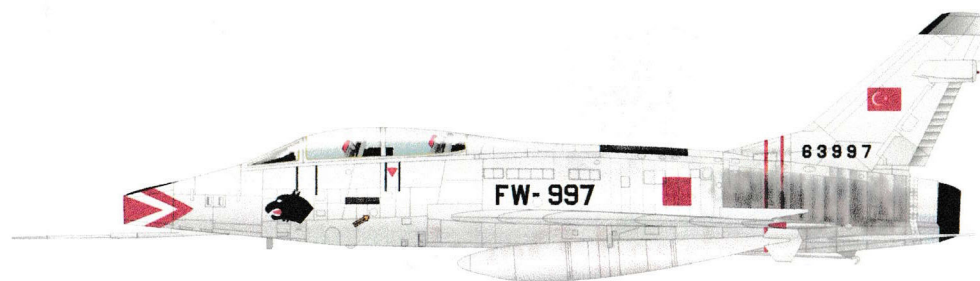

Starting in 1958 the TuAF started receiving F-100s within the MAP program. The first arrivals were the F-100D and the F-100F models supplied from the USAF inventory. A total of 163 were received. This quantity include very few examples from the Royal Danish Air Force. This turnover was followed by the F-100Cs starting in 1972 , 115 of which were despatched to the TuAF. They were deployed at at least five air bases. They were extensively used during the Cyprus "Peace Keeping Operation". The last F-100 retires in 1988.



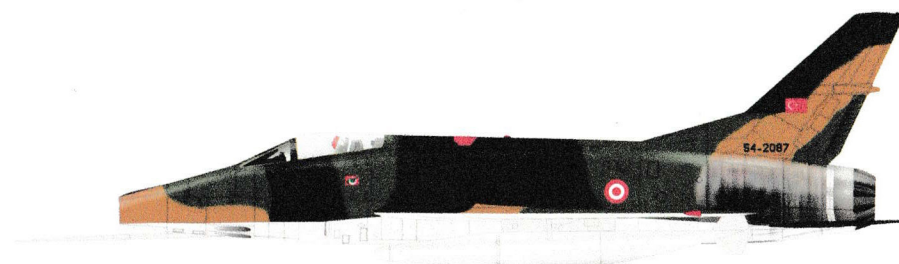
The profile artwork of the F-100D (54-2238) which was one of the three Super Sabres were that shot down by AAA during the operation.



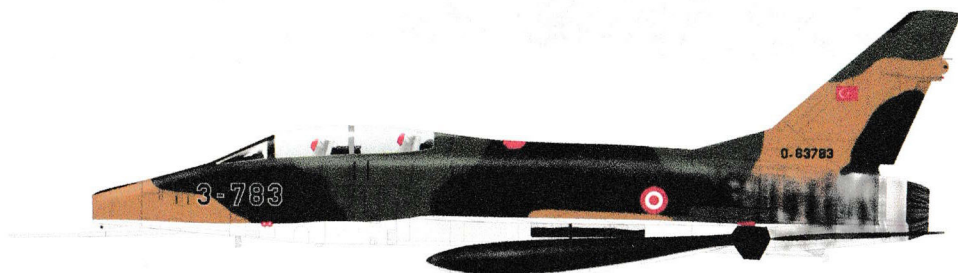
A very popular F-100F(56-3997) of Panther Filo (Squadron).

One of the most interesting F-100F (56-3783) of Konya. This particular aircraft was carrying AN/APG-25/26 RHAW antennae on the nose and tail which was proof of the previous Vietnam War experience as "Wild Weasel" and "Misty FAC" special missions.
