

# LIPPISCH LP.13B

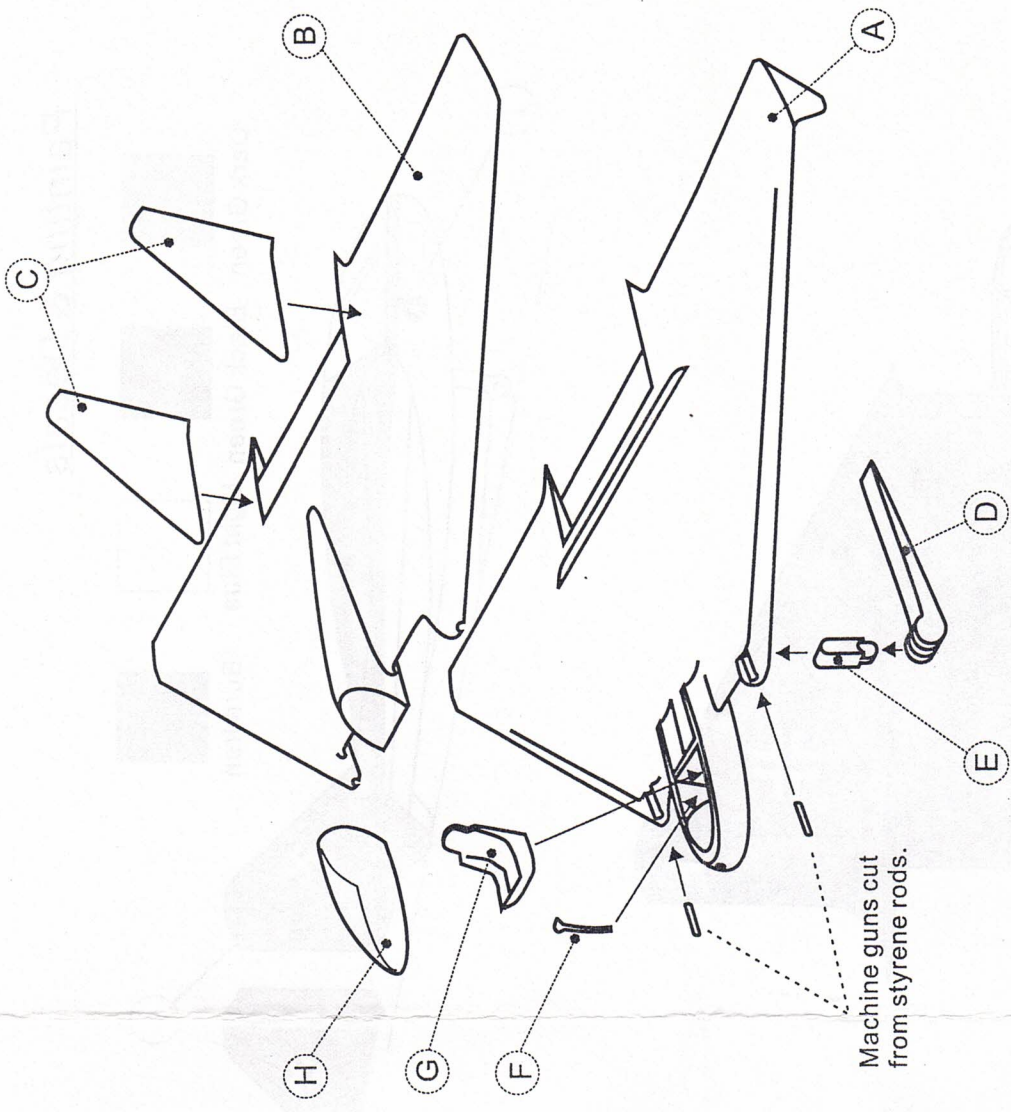
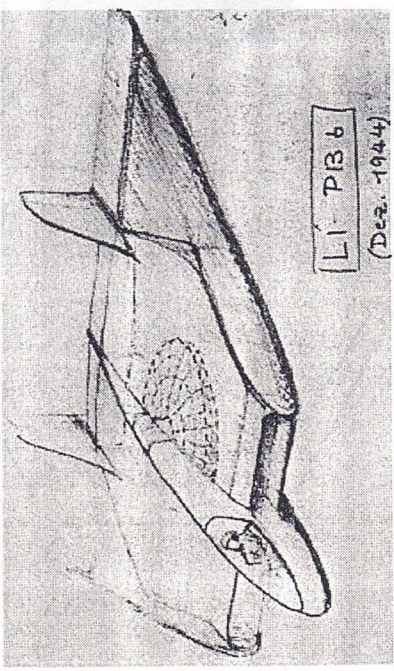
## 1/72 scale resin model kit

In December 1944, the Lippisch P.13b was designed as a ramjet fighter that follow on design from P.13a for its performance modification. It featured a delta wing plan design as previous Lippisch's favourite. Cockpit was moved to forward for better pilot's visibility. The double rudders were subject to provide a steady flight. It planned to use coal for fuel because of the fuel shortage in Germany at war. The main landing gear was a retractable landing skid, and the rear rested on the reinforced wingtips. No actual airplane of this model was built. It just stay in sketches concept stage.
