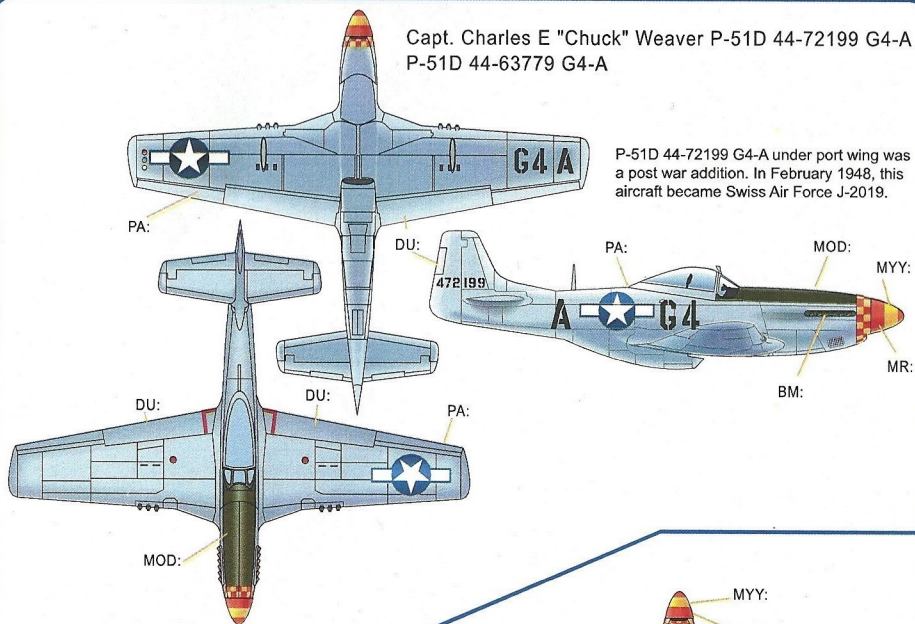
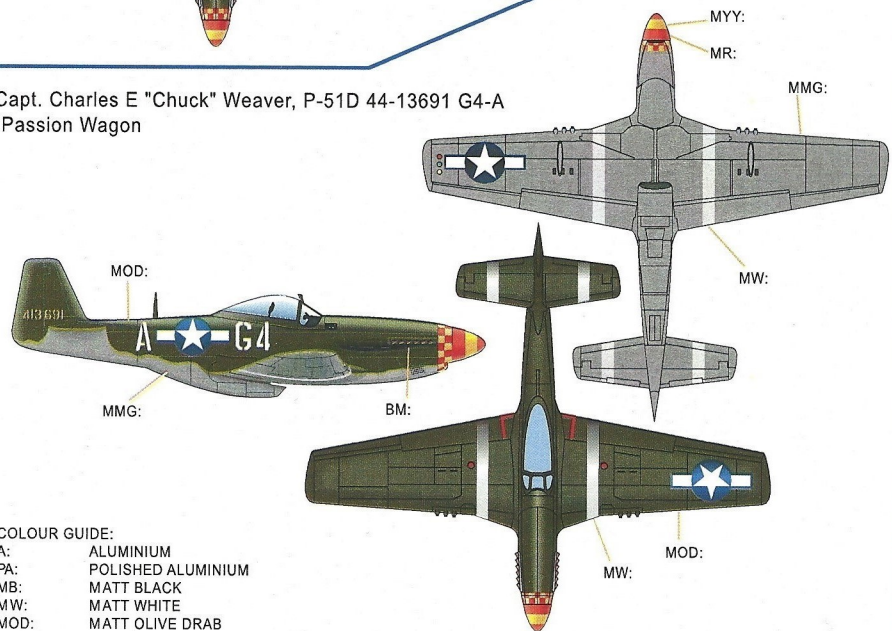

P-51D 44-72199 G4-A under port wing was a post war addition. In February 1948, this aircraft became Swiss Air Force J-2019.



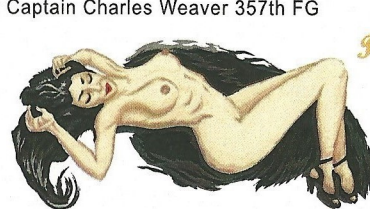

NOTES: The wing surfaces of the P51D were filled and smoothed, removing all surface detail except for fine gaps between panels. This surface was then painted silver - not left as bare metal as is easily assumed from its appearance in photographs. Very little if any rivet detail was visible after this process. This ensured smooth, uninterrupted airflow over the laminar flow wing. All other surfaces (except where indicated) were left bare metal. Recommended Kits: Dragon, Hasegawa, Trumpeter, Tamiya.
