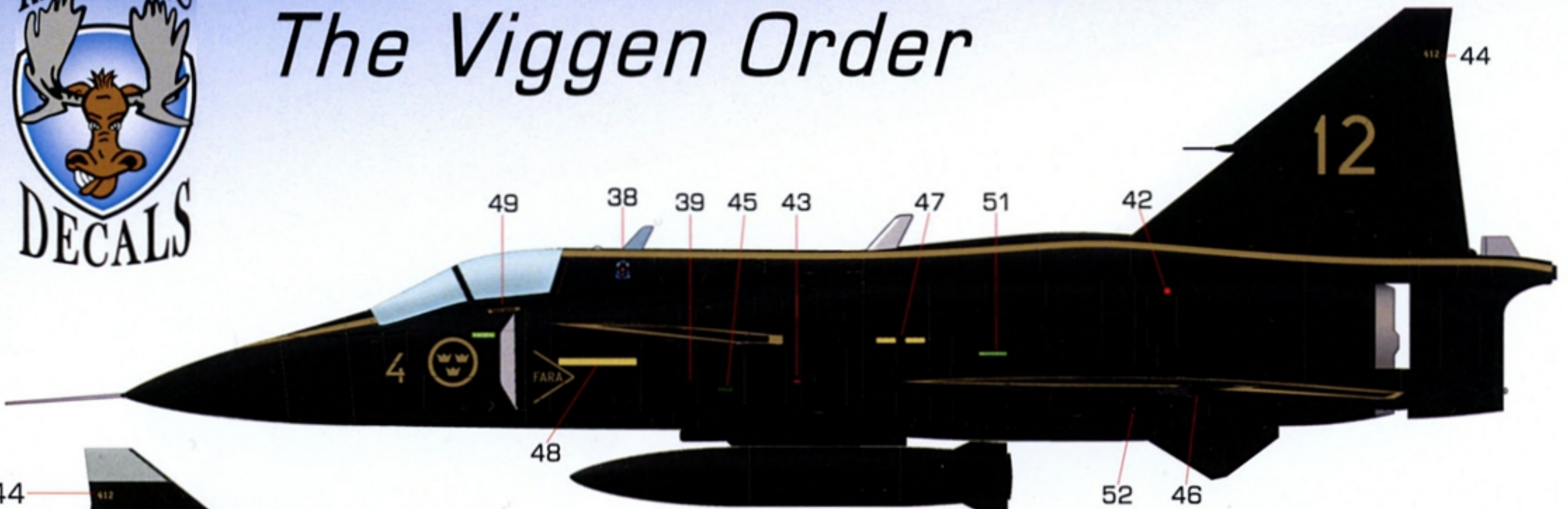
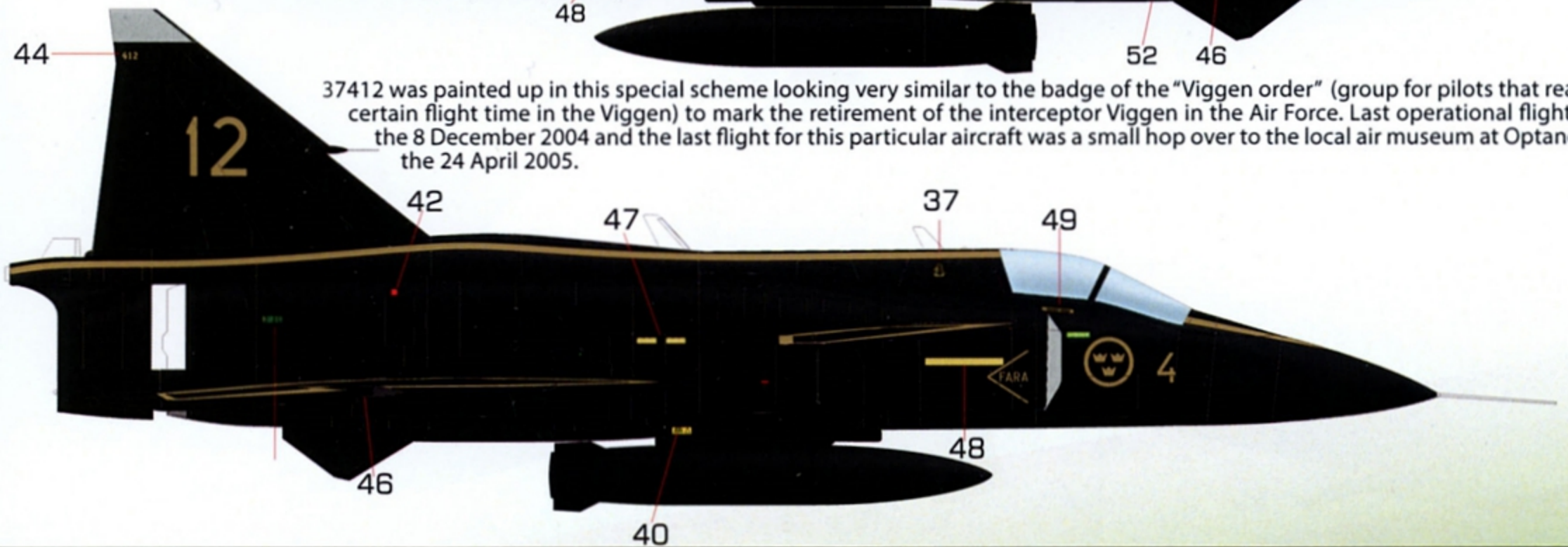


JA 37Di 37412 Viggen
The Viggen Order



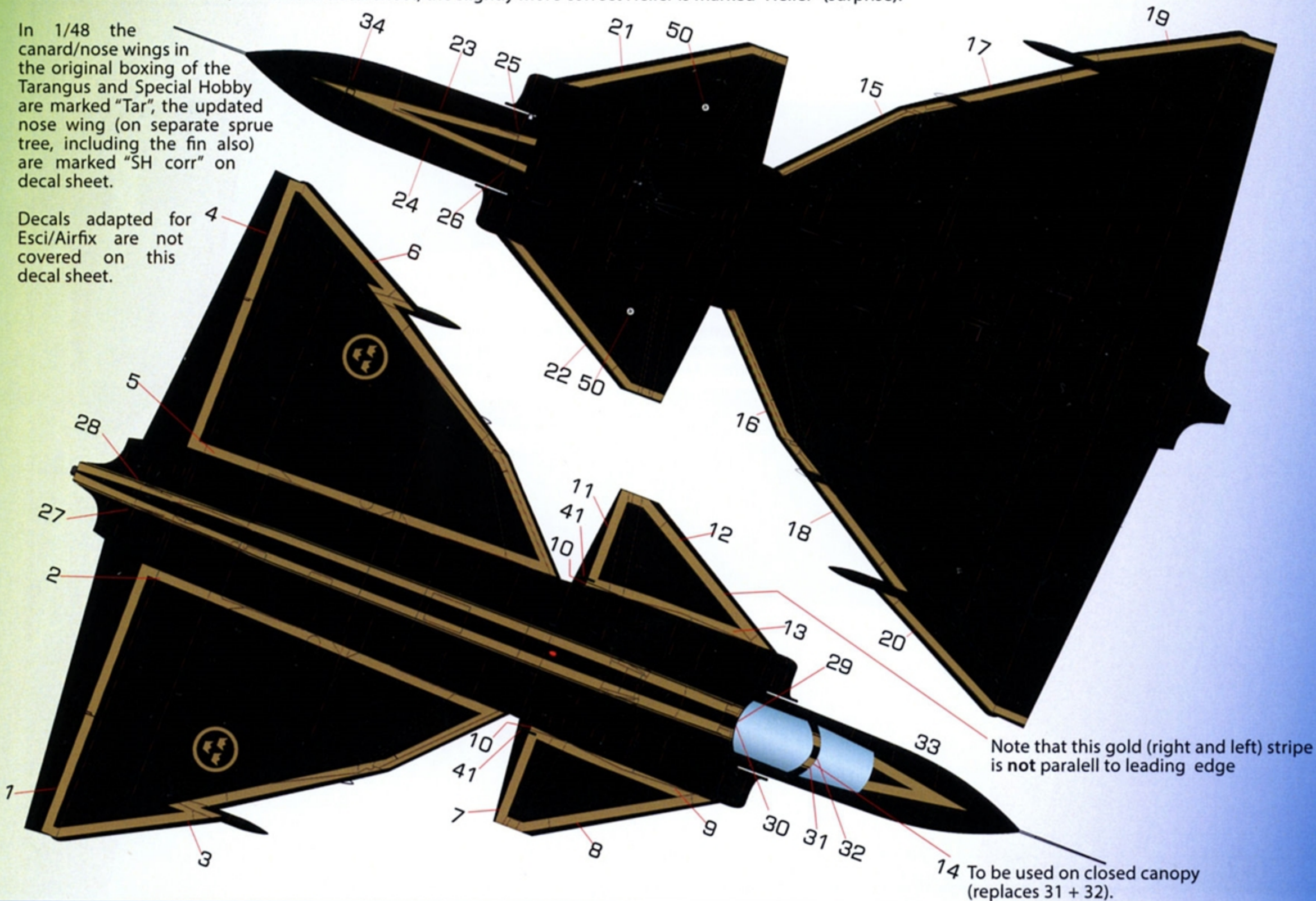
37412 was painted up in this special scheme looking very similar to the badge of the "Viggen order" (group for pilots that reach a certain flight time in the Viggen) to mark the retirement of the interceptor Viggen in the Air Force. Last operational flight was the 8 December 2004 and the last flight for this particular aircraft was a small hop over to the local air museum at Optand on the 24 April 2005.



Plastic models have slightly different shape and these decals are custom designed to fit the different kits. In 1/72, Special Hobby and Tarangus share the same molds and are marked "SH/Tar" on the decal sheet, the slightly more correct Heller is marked "Heller" (surprise).

In 1/48 the canard/nose wings in the original boxing of the Tarangus and Special Hobby are marked "Tar", the updated nose wing (on separate sprue tree, including the fin also) are marked "SH corr" on decal sheet.

Decals adapted for Esci/Airfix are not covered on this decal sheet.



Note that this gold (right and left) stripe is not parallel to leading edge
