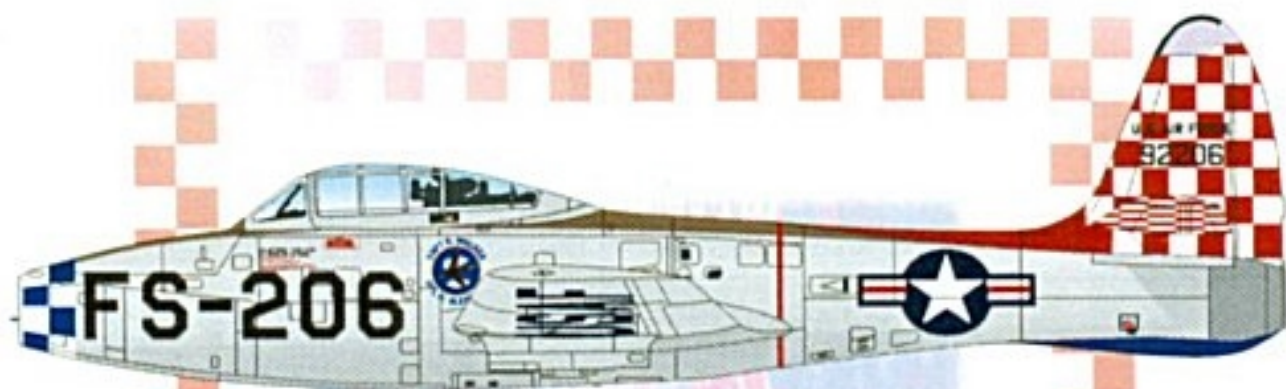

86TH FBG THUNDERJETS Pt. II



Suggested Kit: Monogram-Revell F-84E Thunderjet



Republic F-84E-5-RE Thunderjet 49-2206. Assigned to the 525th Fighter-Bomber Squadron, 86th F-B Group based at Neubiberg, Germany, in 1951/52. Overall natural metal finish with Flat Olive Green FS34079 antiglare panel, Red and white checkerboard tail was the 86th F-B Group's distinctive marking. Nose, tip tank, and tail skid colors identified the squadron - blue for the 525th F-B. Tail skid on aft fuselage in the squadron color, Gloss Blue FS15182. Top of vertical tail Light Gray approximately FS36628. Paint horizontal tail and remainder of vertical tail Gloss White before applying the Red checkerboard decals. Paint wing tip tanks Gloss Blue FS15182 before applying white checkerboard decals. The squadron badge was carried on the left side of the fuselage and the wing badge in the same location on the right side.



Republic F-84E-30-RE Thunderjet 51-626. Assigned to the 526th Fighter-Bomber Squadron, 86th F-B Group at Neubiberg, Germany, in 1951/52. Overall natural metal finish with Flat Olive Green FS34079 antiglare panel. Tail skid and command stripes on aft fuselage in the squadron color, Gloss Red FS11136. Top of vertical tail Light Gray approximately FS36628. Paint horizontal tail and remainder of vertical tail White, before applying the Red checkers. Paint wing tip tanks Gloss Red FS11136 before applying white checkerboard decals. The squadron badge was carried on the left side of the fuselage and the wing badge in the same location on the right side. Note the non-standard presentation of the radio call number on the fin.

Republic F-84E-5-RE Thunderjet 49-2132. Assigned to the 527th Fighter-Bomber Squadron, 86th F-B Group at Neubiberg, Germany, in 1951/52. Overall natural metal finish with Flat Olive Green FS34079 antiglare panel. Tail skid on aft fuselage in the 527 F-B color, Gloss Yellow FS13538. Top of vertical tail Light Gray approximately FS36628. Paint horizontal tail and remainder of vertical tail Gloss White before applying Red checkerboard decals. Paint wing tip tanks Gloss Yellow FS13538 before applying black checkerboard decals. The squadron badge was carried on the left side of the fuselage and the wing badge in the same location on the right side. Note that FS-132 flew with the old unbraced canopy before the new canopy was fitted.
