Colors: Overall natural metal. No ID bands on wings and tail. Nose and spinner: Black, White and Red.
Anti-glare panel: OD bordered in Red. Rudder, fin cap and tips of horizontal stabilizers: Black.
Red trim around the exhaust stacks.

Invasion stripes on lower wings and fuselage. Spinner: Green/Yellow/Green.

Upper surfaces of fuselage and horizontal surfaces: Green bordered in Red

Nose and spinner: Medium Blue with Blue overspray on base of propeller blades.
