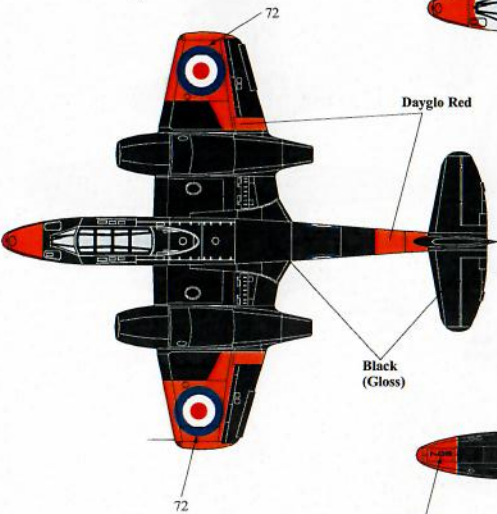
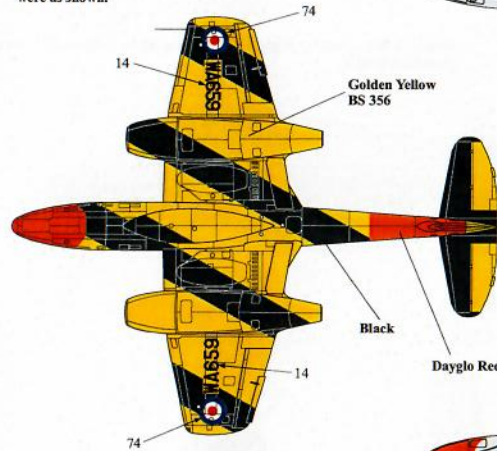
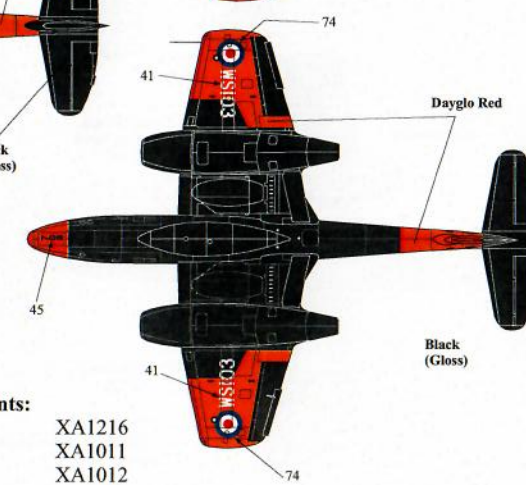
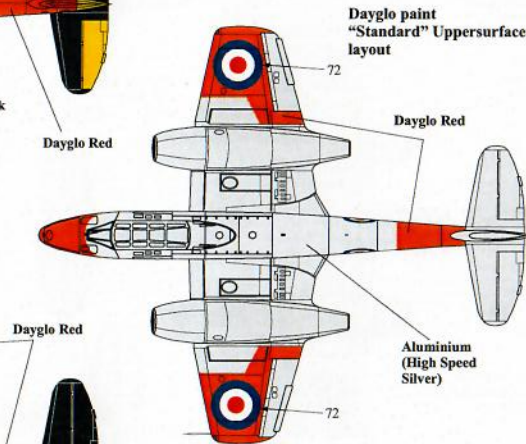
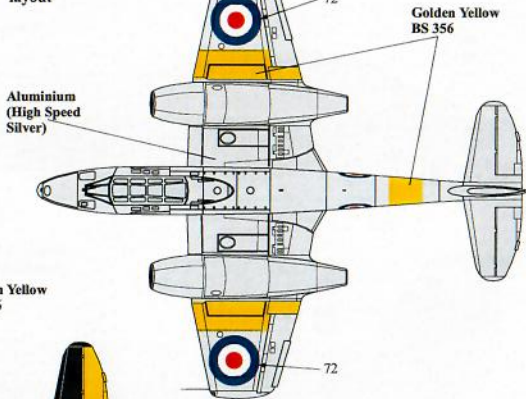


NOTE: Normally TT stripes are centred on the starboard roundel, however, the visible positions of black and yellow in the side view suggest (in this instance) they were as shown.

"Standard" Uppersurface layout



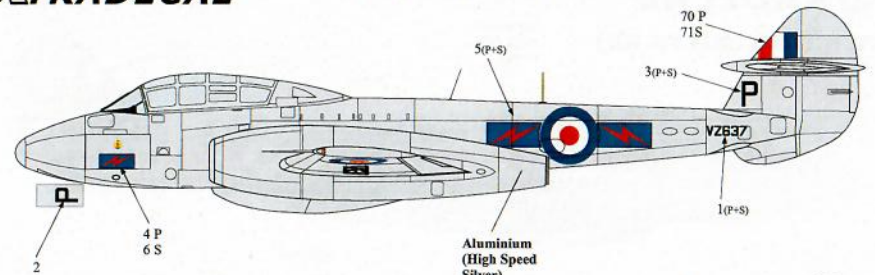

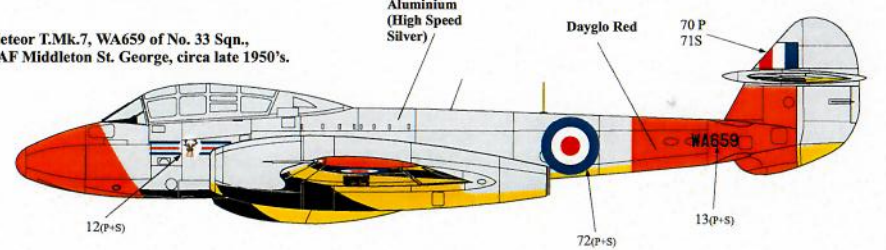

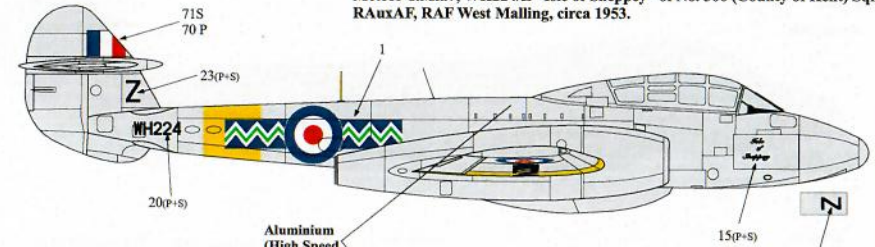

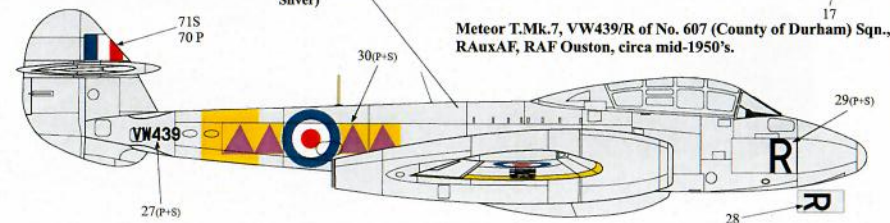

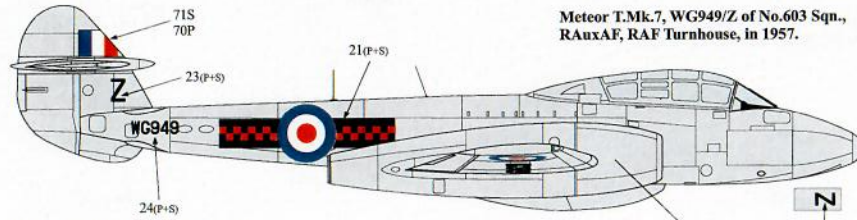

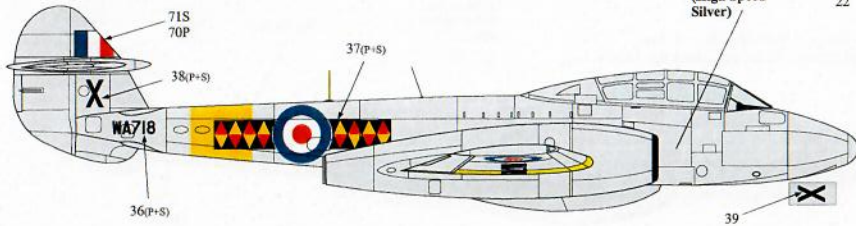

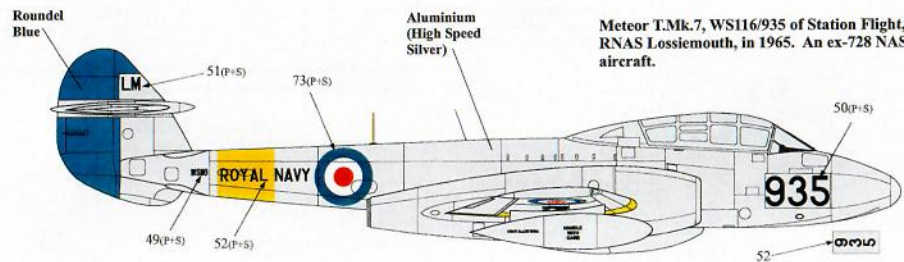
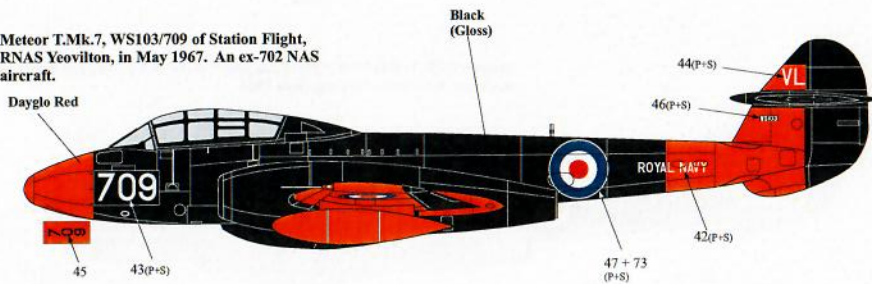

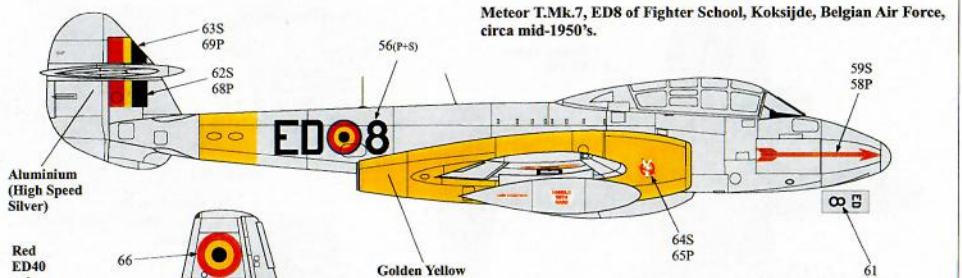
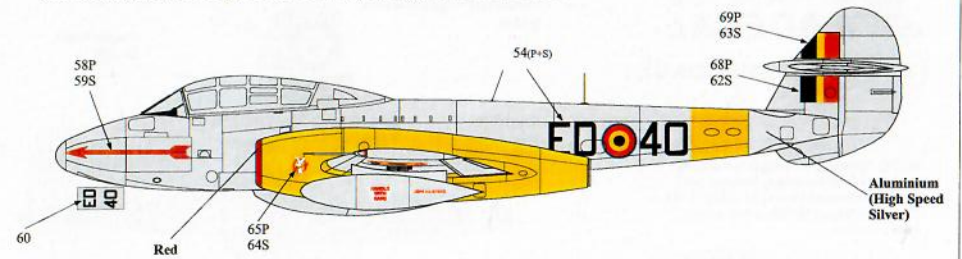
