

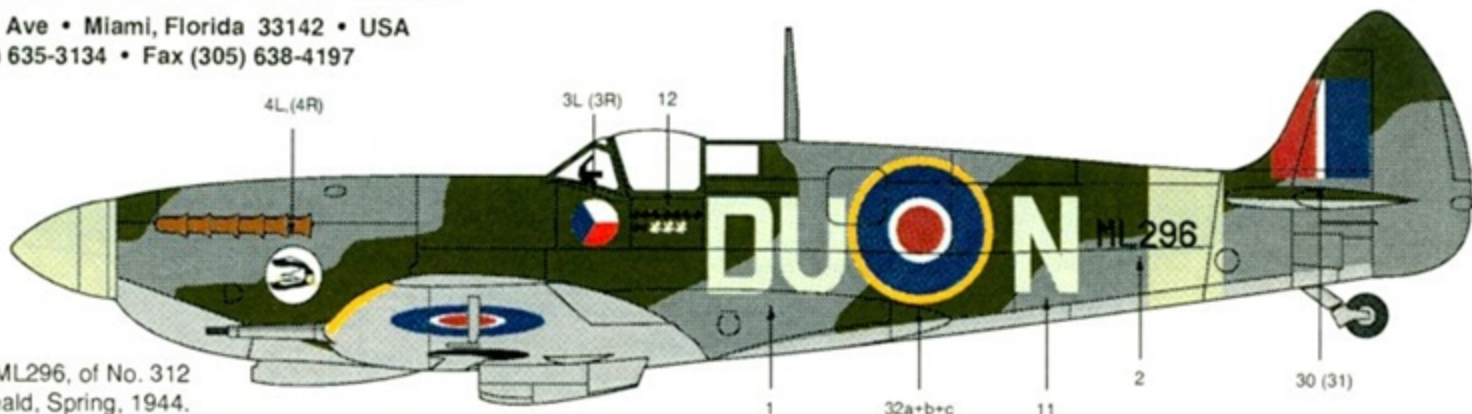

 leading wing edges.



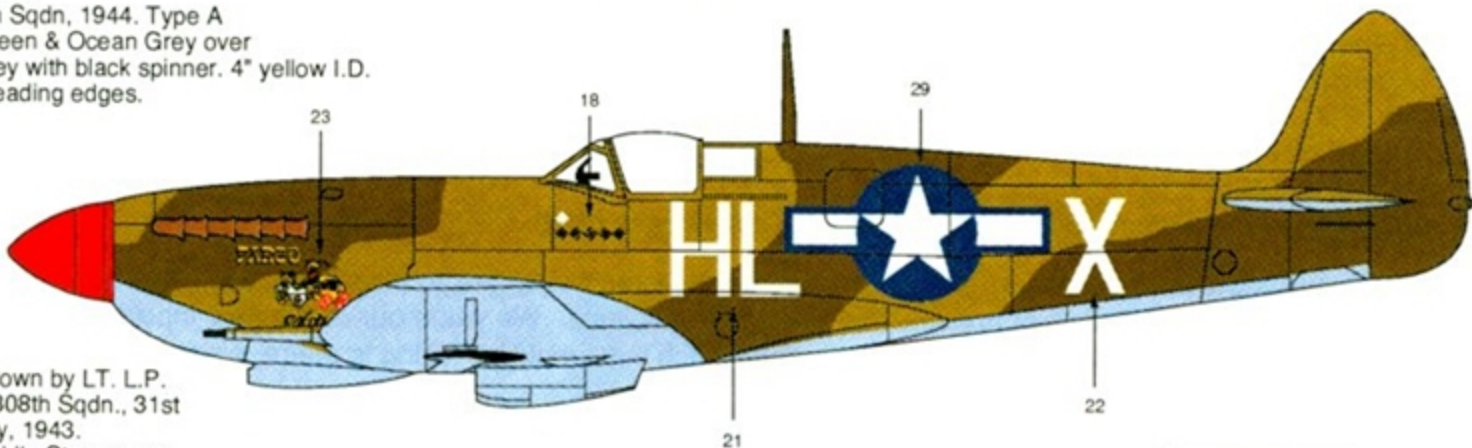

 edges.

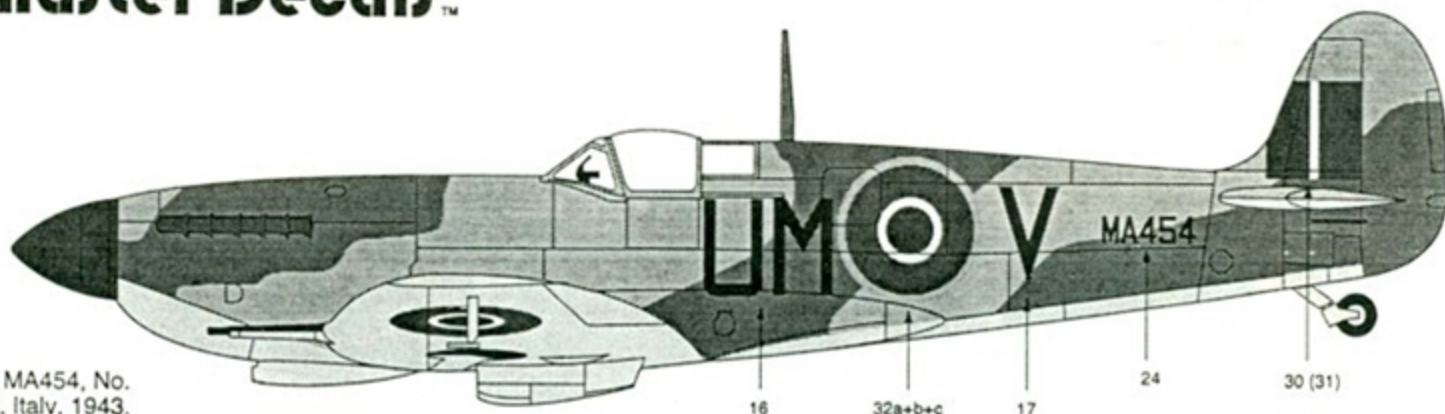

 bands on wing leading edges.

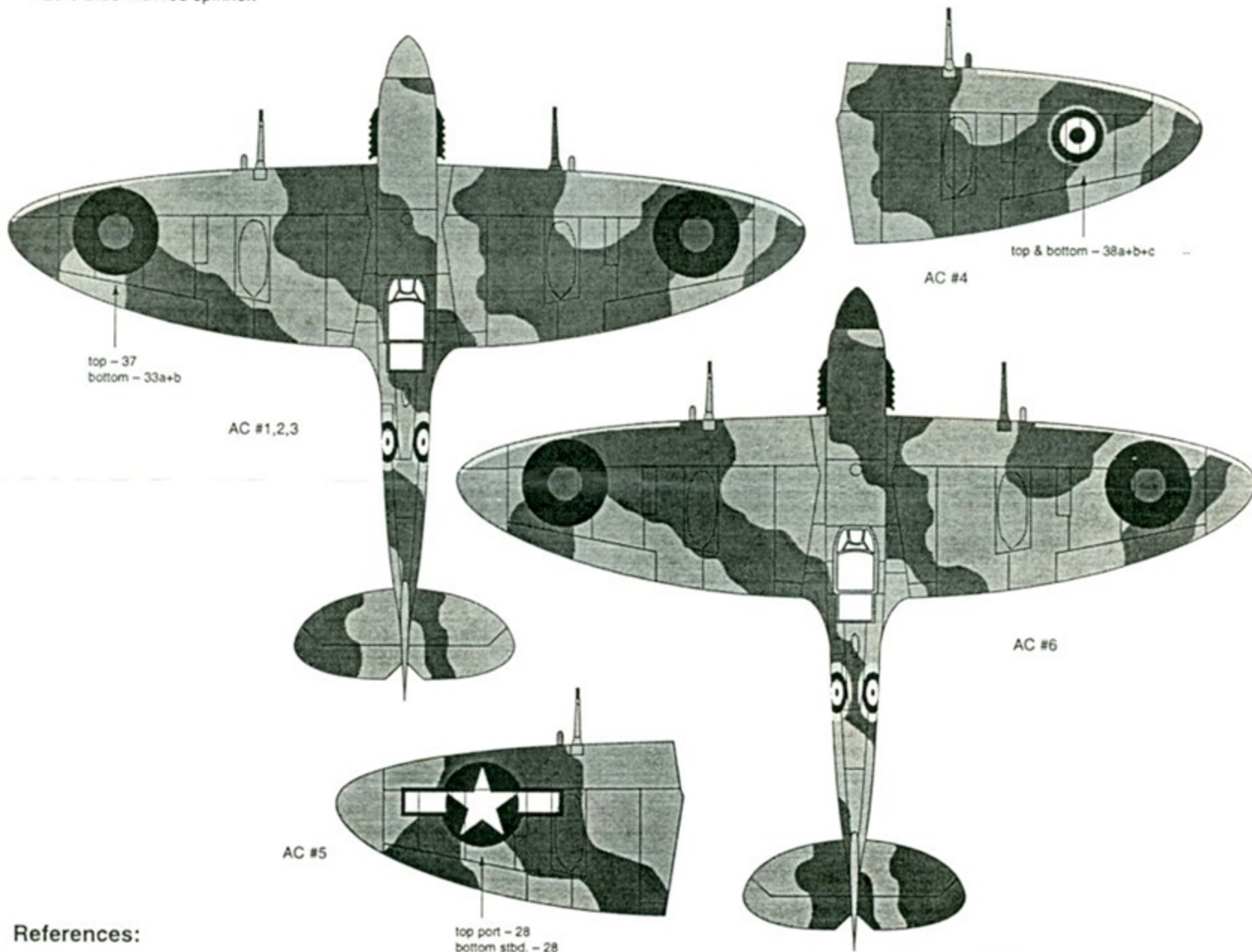


AC #5
