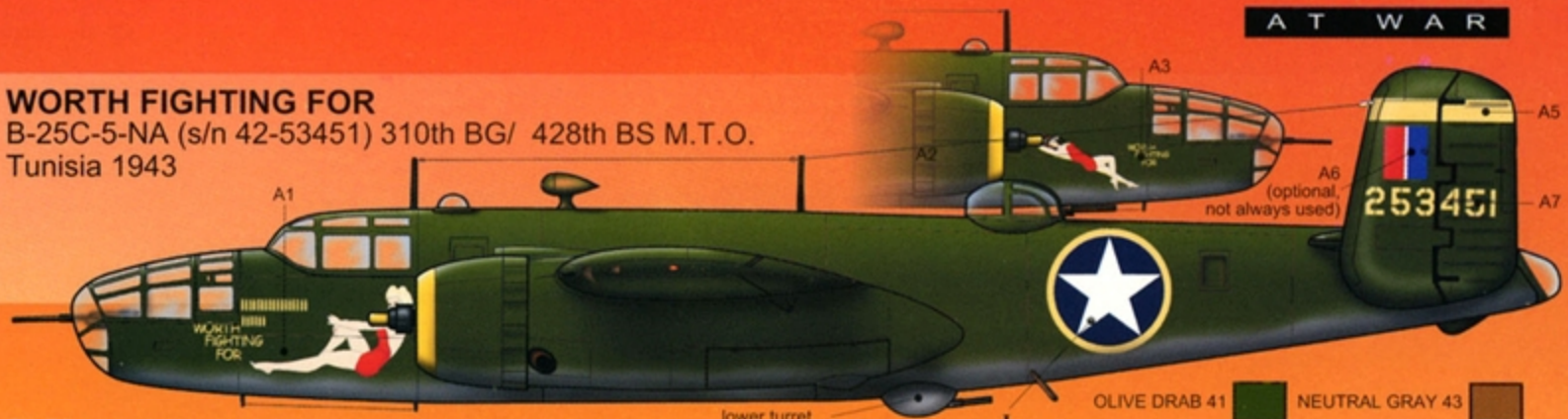

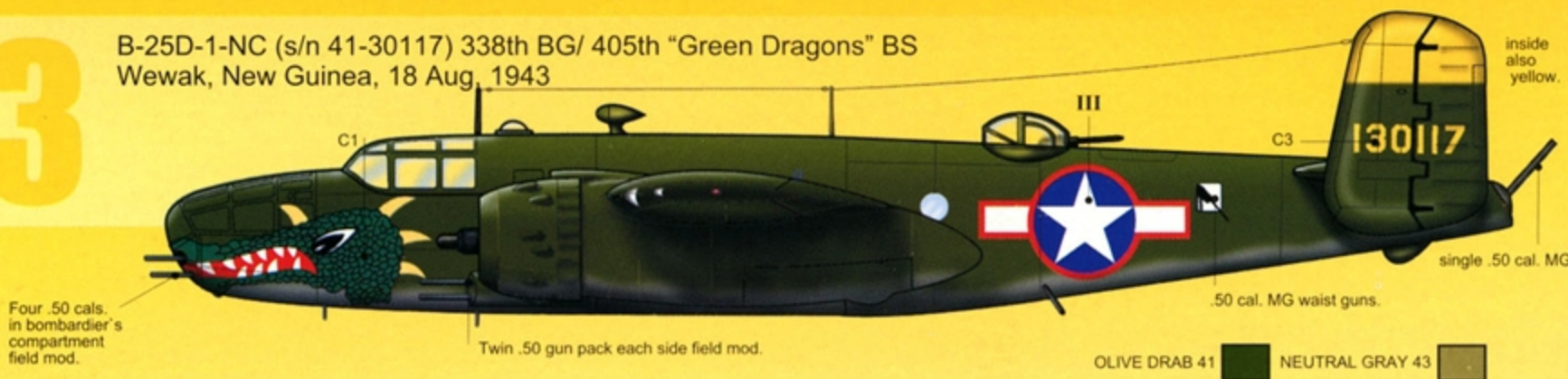

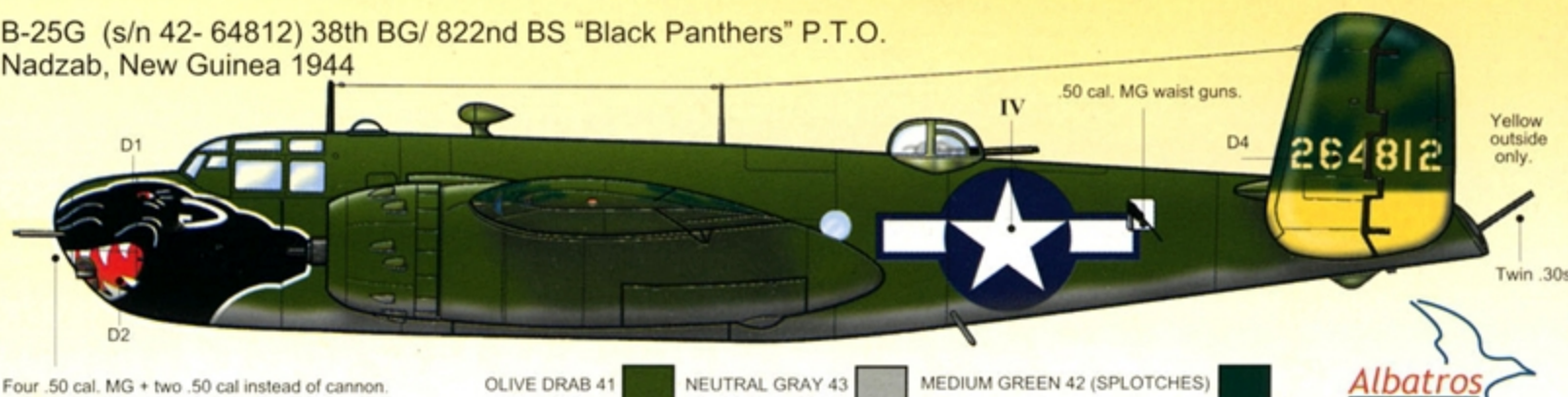
### Medal of Honor

For conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity above and beyond the call of duty in action with the enemy.

While Maj. Cheli was leading his squadron in a dive to attack the heavily defended Dagua Airdrome, intercepting enemy aircraft centered their fire on his plane causing it to burst into flames while still two miles from the objective. His speed would have enabled him to gain necessary altitude to parachute to safety, but his action would have resulted in his formation becoming disorganized and exposed to the enemy. Although a crash was inevitable, he courageously elected to continue leading the attack in his blazing airplane. From a minimum altitude, the squadron made a devastating bombing and strafing attack on the target. The mission completed, Maj. Cheli instructed his wing man to lead the formation and crashed into the sea.

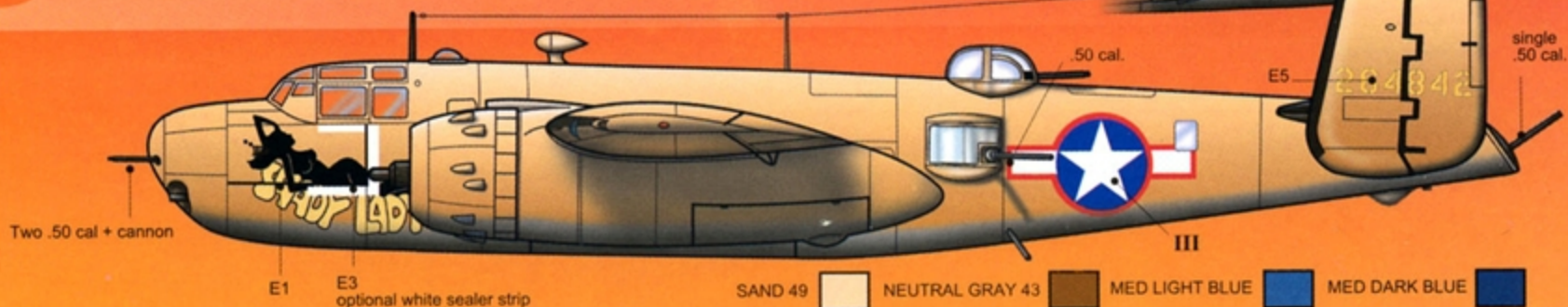
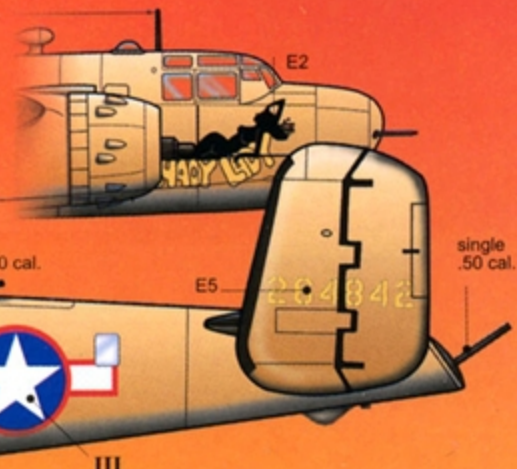

NOTE: Fairfax waist gun installation modification. Rear gun enclosure canopy, later modified to a two gun installation. No bottom turret. Originally painted in Sand/Neutral gray. Later de-icers removed and repainted Mediterranean dark blue (topside), the bottom's in Mediterranean light blue. Not confirmed if pin-up girl was retained. Almost certainly that national insignia was repainted with a blue surround and the s/n in yellow.

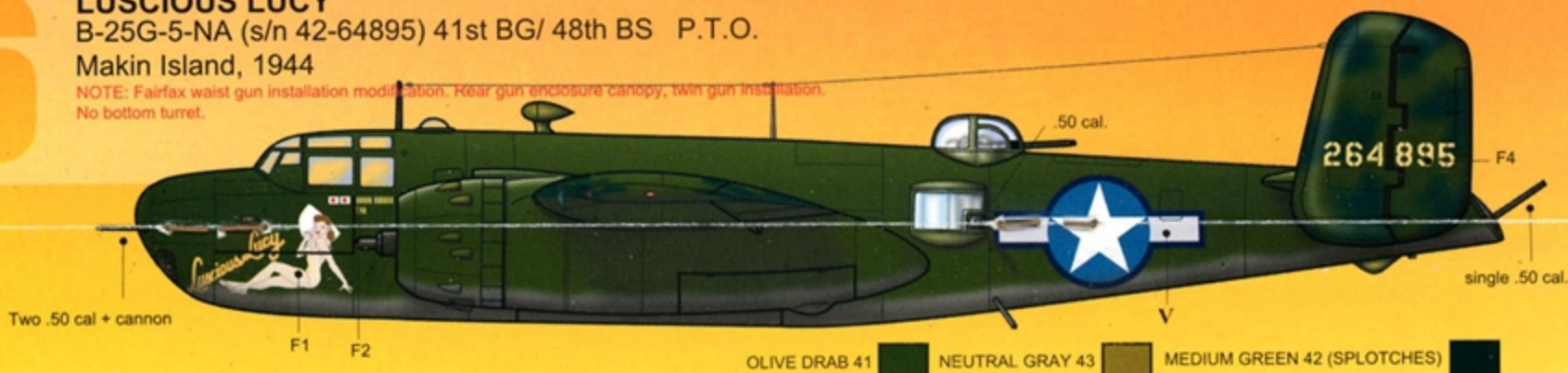

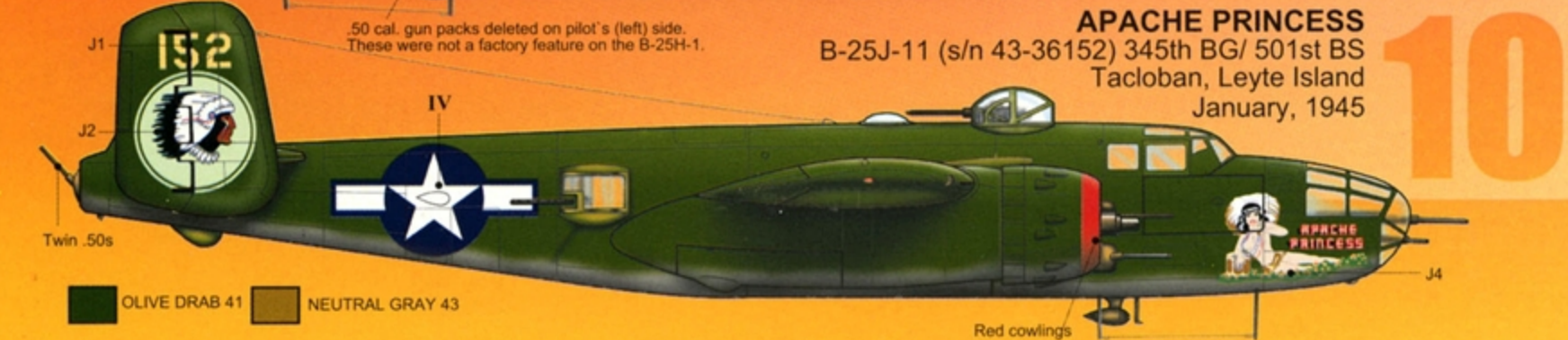

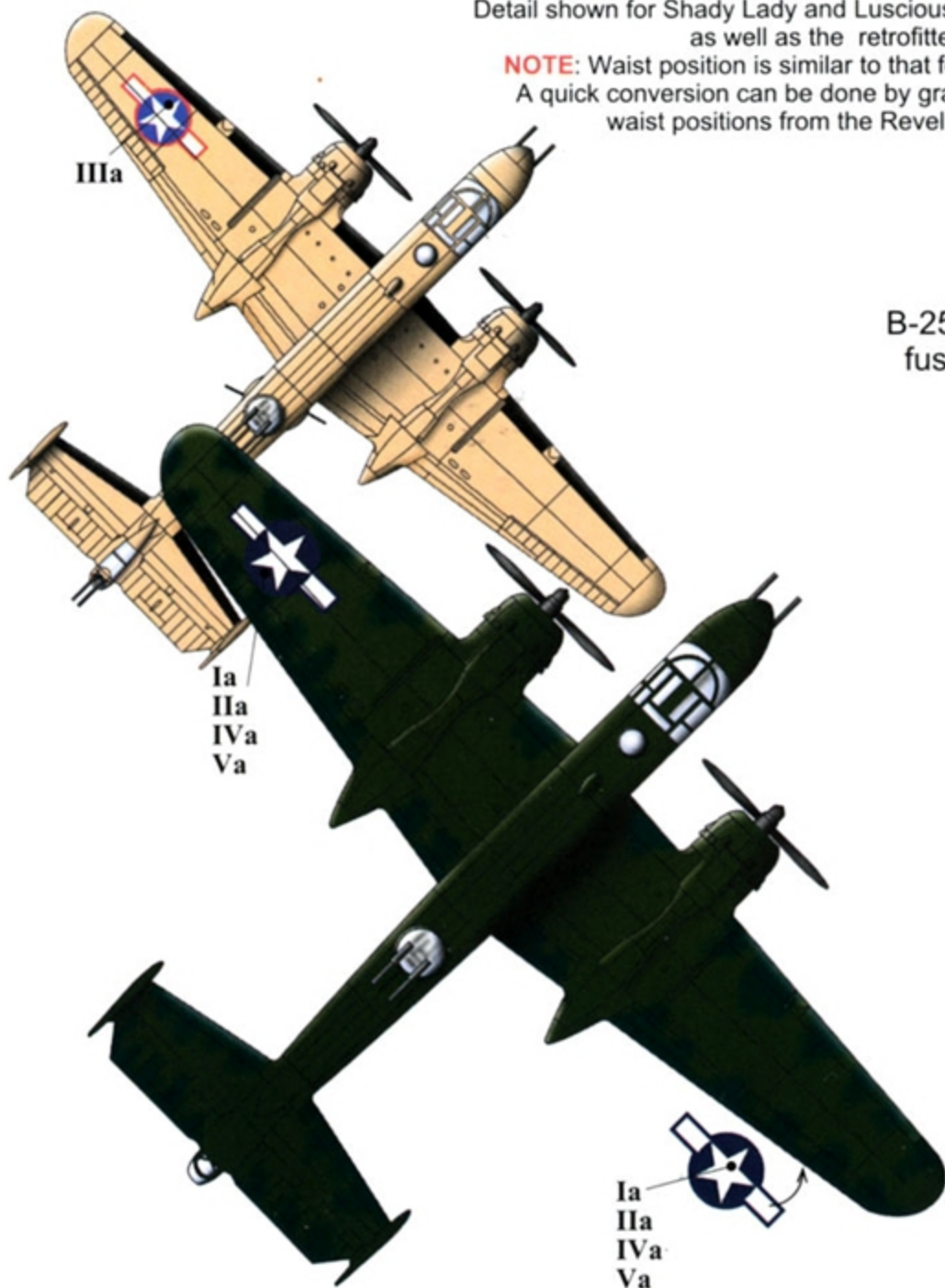
