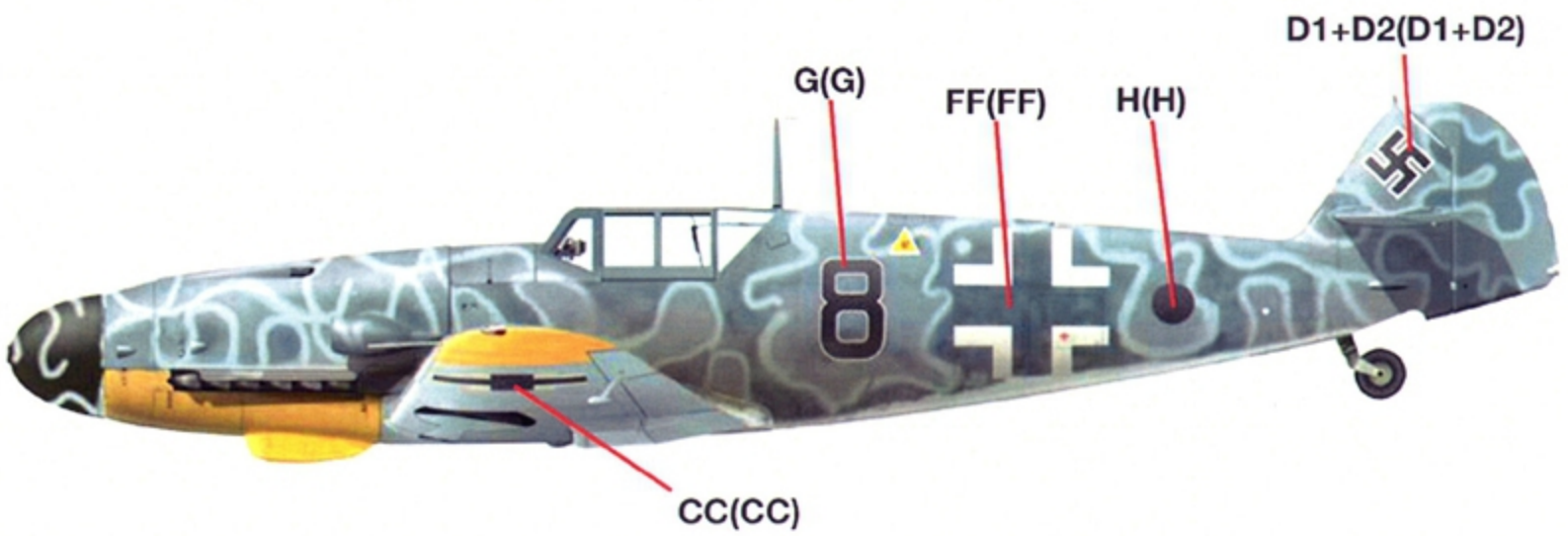
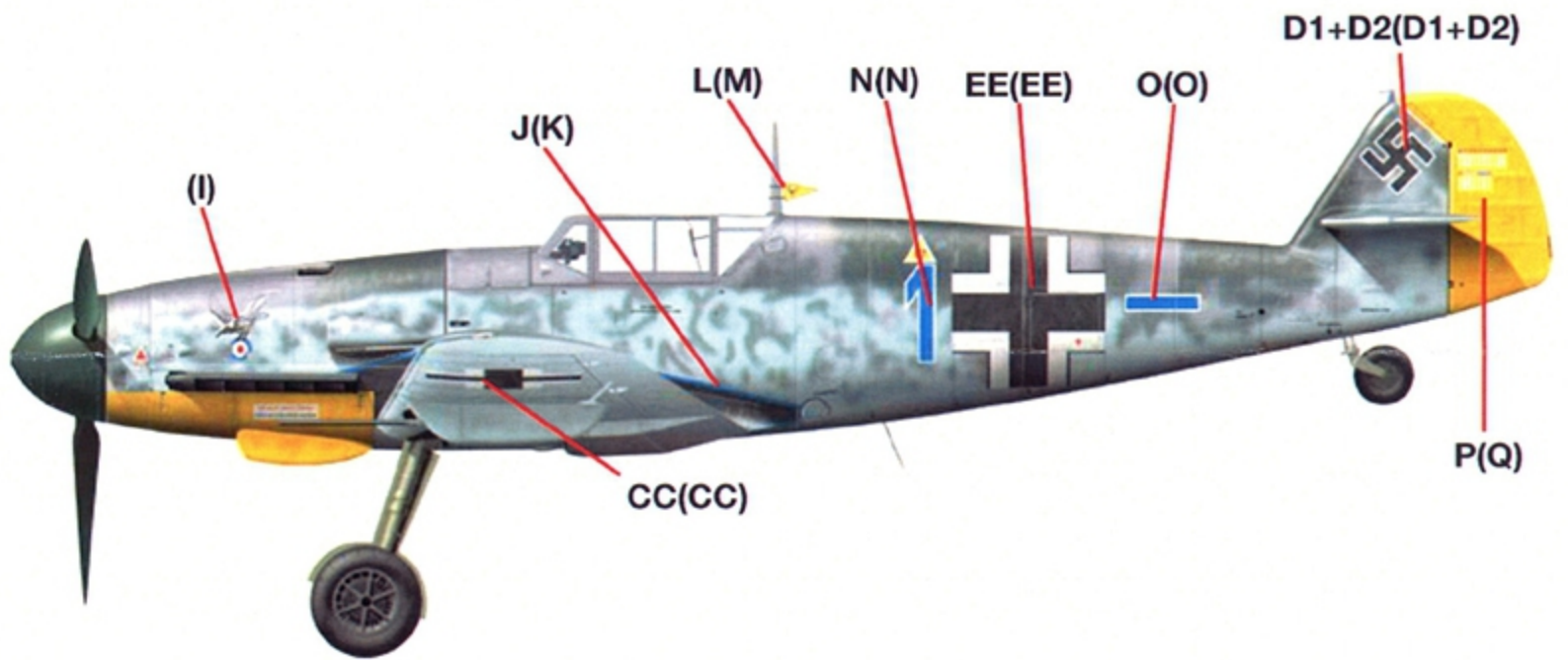
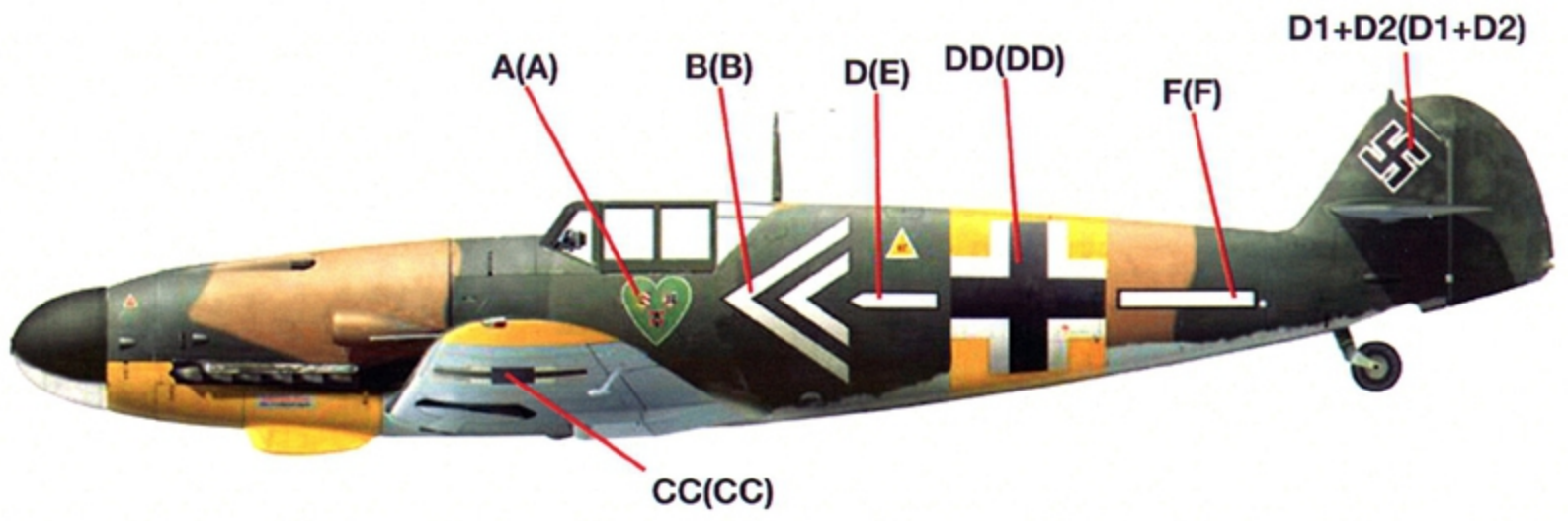
"Double Chevron" Bf 109 G-2 *Major Hannes Trautloft Kommodore JG 54*
possibly Siwerskaja, Russia, early August 1942

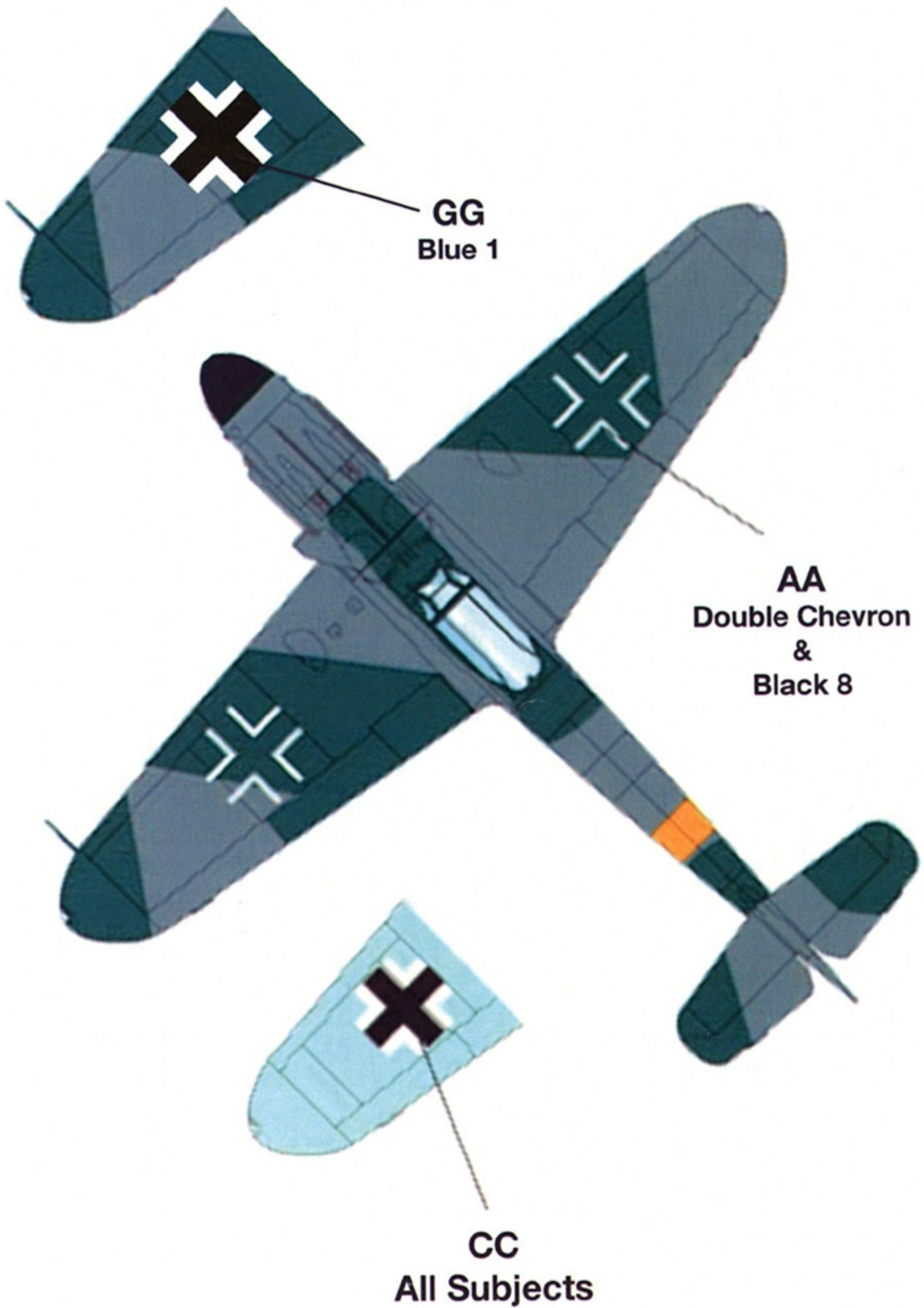


"Blue 1" *Staffelkapitän Lt. Georg-Peter Eder of 12./JG 2*

Bf 109 G-2/4s

"Double Chevron" Bf 109 G-2 JG 54 W.Nr. unknown Possibly Siwerskaja, Russia Early August 1942

Pilot: *Major Hannes Trautloft Kommodore JG 54*

Non-pressurized aircraft; however, canopy has solid sealed armor panel.

Colors: Under surfaces; RLM 76

Upper surfaces; RLM 79 Sand Gelb with segments of RLM 71 Dark Green

Spinner; 2/3 RLM 70 Black Green and 1/3 White segment

Yellow under cowling, under wing tips and fuselage band behind cross.

National Markings: Fuselage; 900 mm Black and White crosses

Hakenkreuz; 300 mm Black with white outline

Wings: Upper; 1000 mm White outline crosses filled with RLM 71

Lower; 900 mm Black with White outline crosses

Stenciling: Over painted. Large JG 54 Green Hearts emblem on both sides of fuselage under canopy

"Blue 1" Bf 109 G-4 12./JG 2 W.Nr. 14998 Beaumont-le-Roger, France March 1943

Pilot: *Staffelkapitän Lt. Georg-Peter Eder*

Overhead pilot armor in cockpit; FuG 25a antenna; spoke wheels; MG 151 20 mm cannon pods mounted; *Staffelkapitän* pennant on antenna mast.

Colors: Under surfaces: RLM 76

Upper surfaces; RLM 76 Gray-Violet/RLM 74 Gray-Green

Yellow under cowling and rudder with 17 victory bars

Black design on wing root trimmed in *Staffel* color Blue

Spinner and prop; RLM 70 Black-Green

National Markings: Fuselage; 900 mm Black/White with thin Black trim crosses

Hakenkreuz; 300 mm Black with White outline

Wings: Upper; 1000 mm Black with White outline crosses

Lower; 900 mm crosses

Stenciling: Factory standard; 12./JG 2 emblem on port side of engine cowling

"Black 8" Bf 109 G-2 8./JG 5 W.Nr. unknown Petsamo, Finland (Russia) Winter 1943-1944

Pilot: *Obfw. Jakob Norz*

Colors: Under surfaces; RLM 76

Upper surfaces; non-standard application of RLM 75 and RLM 74 with random lines of RLM 76 applied over the Grays

Yellow under cowling, upper and lower wing tips

Spinner: RLM 70 Black-Green with RLM 76 squiggles

National Markings: Fuselage; 900 mm White outline crosses filled with RLM 74

Hakenkreuz; 300 mm Black with White outline

Wings: Upper; 1000 mm White outline crosses

Lower; 900 mm Black with White outline crosses

Stenciling: Over painted
